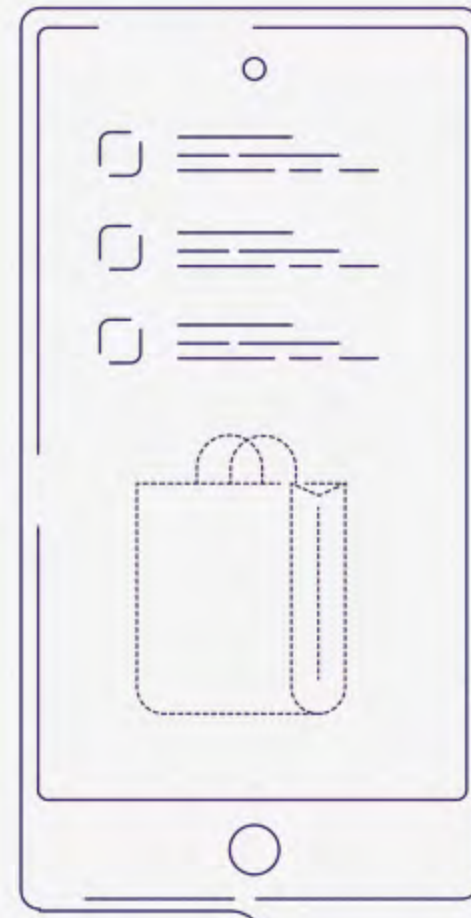


The CyberStronger checklist for cyber secure online shopping.



1

Don't click on links in emails.

Instead, go to the trusted website by typing in the address.



2

Don't shop over a free public Wi-Fi.

Hackers might be using the same connection.



3

Shop at trusted outlets.

It's good to check if a new online store had good references and customer reviews.



4

Do your research.

Multiple reports of fraud are a good indicator that you should take your money elsewhere.



5

Use a strong password for your shopping accounts.

Better yet, don't save your payment information in your profile.



6

Use safer payment options.

By using PayPal, Google Pay or ApplePay, you won't be giving away your credit card information directly.



7

Don't give out too much information.

If a website asks for very personal details, chances are they aren't legit.



8

Check the webpage's security.

Make sure the URL starts with a HTTPS and has a little lock sign in front of it.



9

Check your credit card statement regularly.

A fake charge, even if it's small, should not go unreported.
